

Nine students recently completed our Health and Welfare SETA (HWSETA)-accredited Health and Frail Care Programme to equip them to become either a nurse's assistant or a frail care assistant and provide care to a sick or frail patient, an elderly person, or a sick baby or child. During the full-time 15-week programme students cover modules such as ethical care at health care centres and in private homes, basic anatomy, how to assist immobile patients, and baby and child care. The programme consists of 5 weeks of theoretical and practical training in a classroom setting followed by a 10-week work-integrated learning opportunity offered at one of 26 different care institutions in the Western Cape. 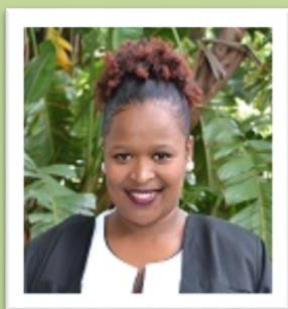
**Name: Berenice October**

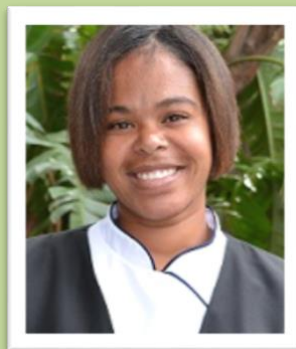
